There will be a catered dinner Saturday evening at 6:30 after the L2-L5 Speed Course Walk. The cost <u>per plate</u> will be \$30. If you would like to join us, please indicate on your entry form how many tickets you would like. Additional tickets will be available in the Show Office on Thursday and Friday.

Awards Ceremony

The L1 Awards Ceremony will be held on Saturday, October 18 at 5:45 PM. The L2-L7 Awards Ceremony will be held at the close of the show on Sunday. Winners will be recognized and awarded their rosettes and prizes. We ask that all Champions and Reserve Champions and their horses (either in hand or under saddle) be present for photos. Competition Requirements

Eastern Regions Championship Show

Only USAWE current members are eligible to compete in a championship show. A horse-rider combination must earn a combined average of 58% or higher in Dressage and EOH (L1-L7) and successfully complete the Speed trial (L2-L7) at a minimum of two licensed shows.

For the 2025 competition year, the qualifying period is January 1, 2024 through the show entry deadline in 2025. At least one of the scores must be earned during the current competition year.

WE Show at Meadow Event Park

The **WE Show at Meadow Event Park** is for competitors who did not meet the qualifying criteria for the Championship show. All competitors must hold a current membership with USAWE.

All competing horses must be recorded with USAWE in advance of the show. A one-time fee of \$30 per horse includes lifetime performance tracking.

Riders with disabilities can apply for a Dispensation Certificate that approves the use of adaptive equipment and other allowances. The certificate must be approved prior to the competition and a copy submitted with the entry form.

Eastern Regions Cattle Trial

The Cattle Trial is optional and open to L2-L7 Championship Show competitors first. If the trial does not fill, L2-L7 competitors in the WE at Meadow Event Park competitors will be given the opportunity to enter.



Prizes/Awards

- Champion, Reserve Champion, and third thru sixth place rosettes will be awarded to the overall Horse-Rider teams in each level/division. Prizes and/or monies may be award to the Champion and Reserve Champion, as well, depending on sponsorships.
- Rosettes are awarded from 1st thru 6th place for all divisions in each level.
- Several breed-specific awards will be offered. They will be determined by the highest average Dressage/EOH
 score from all levels/divisions for that breed. The list of breeds sponsored will be announced after the close of
 entries.
- There will be an overall High Score award for the top Open, Amateur, and Youth riders for the Championship Show. They will be determined by the highest average Dressage/EOH score from all levels/divisions.
- There will be an overall High Score Dressage, High Score EOH, and Fastest Speed awards for the WE at Meadow Event Park Show. There may be other special awards given depending on sponsorships.
- An **Awards Ceremony** will be held for the L1 competitors on Saturday. For the L2-L7 competitors, it will be held at the close of the show on Sunday. The **required protocol is as follows:**
 - o Rider must be in show attire.
 - o Rider may be mounted or dismounted.
 - o Horse may be in full tack or bridle only with their bridle number attached.

Entry Procedures

• A separate entry form must be completed for each Horse-Rider combination **for each show**. The online forms may be found below.

If you are unable to submit the forms electronically, the hard copies are included with this prize list. Please mail the forms to the Show Secretary along with a check made payable to Working Equitation East.

- Championship Show competitors: Be sure to include your qualifying scores on the entry form.
- L2 L7 competitors: You may indicate a specific song and version on your entry form that you would like to have for your Speed trial. If no song is indicated, we will choose for you.
- An entry form is not valid unless it is fully completed and has all the **proper signatures**, **membership numbers**, and **horse information**. Each entry form must have the original signatures (not copies) of Riders/Handlers and Owner/Agent. An adult must sign for any youth rider.
- Entries must be received by the closing date. Entries received after the closing date will be assessed a \$50 late fee. Late entries will be placed on a waiting list and included in the schedule, if possible.
- No phone entries will be accepted.
- Entries are accepted on a first-paid, first-served basis.
- For the Championship Show, there will be a **Veterinarian Inspection** on check-in day. **Veterinarian Protocol is as follows:**
 - O Competitors must be dressed in appropriate attire slacks or breeches, collared shirt, and horse appropriate footwear (jacket is optional).

- Horses must be clean and presented with a halter or bridle with the bridle number attached.
- o If a presentation time is assigned, please be on time.
- Photocopy of a negative Coggins test, dated no earlier than October 19, 2024, is required and <u>must be</u>
 <u>emailed to the secretary</u> for online entries or mailed with the hard copy entry forms. Entries without a current (valid through show date) negative Coggins test result will not be allowed to show or remain on the premises.
- Any non-competing horses must have an entry form and negative Coggins test submitted by mail or electronically.
- Virginia State law requires a current health certificate for horses arriving from out of state.

Stabling Details

- Virginia State law requires a current **health certificate** for horses arriving from out of state. Your horse cannot be stabled on the grounds without a health certificate or a current negative Coggins test.
- Competitors may show out of their trailer. There will be a \$30 charge (for the weekend).
- Arrival: Wednesday, October 15, 2025, starting at 9:00 a.m.
- **Departure:** Monday, October 19, 2025, by 8:00 a.m.
- Early arrivals/late departures must be coordinated with and approved by the Stable Manager and will be subject to an additional \$40 charge per stall per day.
- Emergency contact information must be prominently displayed on all stalls housing an animal, including both cell phone and local contact information.
- Shavings may be purchased from Meadow Event Park for \$9/bag.

General Information

The Eastern Regions Championship show and the WE at Meadow Event Park show will be conducted and judged in accordance with the <u>United States Rules for Working Equitation</u>. The <u>WAWE</u> <u>International Working Equitation Regulations</u>, 2025 will also apply to Riders competing in the WAWE Qualifying event.

It is the competitor's responsibility to read and understand the rules prior to the competition.

- Riders must be correctly attired and horses properly presented in accordance with the <u>U.S. Rules for Working Equitation</u> and <u>WAWE International Working Equitation Regulations</u>, as applicable. Show Management may, at its discretion, bar any person or horse from entering the arena if not suitably presented.
- A rider must compete in the division designated on their USAWE membership application, i.e., Youth, Amateur, or Open. See U.S. Rules for Working Equitation, Appendix G, for details.
- Working Equitation East reserves the right to refuse an entry for any reason.

- Working Equitation East and Meadow Event Park reserve the right to maintain a Harassment Free Environment and may remove or refuse entry to any person(s) disrupting the show.
- Hold Harmless Clause: Understanding that horse sports may be hazardous and dangerous, even leading to
 permanent injury or death, each owner, rider, spectator, and other participant assumes any and all risk of loss
 or injury and agrees to hold harmless, regardless, the horse show personnel and the facility hosting the show.
 Working Equitation East and Meadow Event Park will not be responsible for any damage, injury, or loss
 to persons, horses, or property of exhibitors, spectators, or grooms. All local facility rules must be followed.
- Motor Vehicle Operation: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above-described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses, or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.
- Media Release Agreement: Photographs and videos are being taken throughout the course of the competition. Officials, Competitors, Volunteers, and other attendees may take media that captures individuals and horses in the background. No media will be used in any manner to jeopardize any amateur status or advertise any product, outside of promoting USAWE or Working Equitation East. The organization reserves the right to utilize any media it has obtained permissions and rights from the photographers and primary

subjects to use purposes. There associated with



for marketing is no compensation the use of any media.

Facility Requirements

- Smoking Meadow Event Park does not aloe smoking in any of the buildings, including the restrooms at any time. Vapor cigarettes will be considered the same as tobacco cigarettes.
- <u>Firearms Policy</u> Unless an exemption is granted in writing by MEP VP of Operations, all events will abide by the properties policy of no open carry or concealed weapons being allowed on property.
- <u>Animals/Pets</u> The Meadow Event Park does not allow pets of any kind in any on site buildings, except for Service Animals and an approved event such as (dog, cat, horse, or cattle show). Pets in the Horse Area must always be kept on a leash.
- <u>Cruelty to Animals</u> No person shall beat, abuse, or injure any animal while on the Meadow Event Park's property.

- 1. Take U.S. Route 301 to state Route 30; travel about 3 miles west on Route 30. The main entrance to The Meadow Event Park will be on your right, and the Equine Complex will be on your left.
- 2. Take U.S. Route 1 to state Route 30; travel about 2 miles east on Route 30. The main entrance to The Meadow Event Park will be on your left, and the Equine Complex will be on your right.

ENTRY AGREEMENT:

By entering a USAWE-licensed competition and signing this entry form as the Owner, Rider, or Parent/Guardian, I agree that I am subject to and agree to be bound by the Bylaws of USAWE applicable to the USAWE-licensed competition, the <u>U.S. Rules for Working Equitation</u> ("Rules"), and the requirements of the competition as stated in the Prize List. I will accept as final the decision of the Protests Committee or Appeals Committee on any question arising under the Rules and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, USAWE, their officials, officers, directors, employee, agents, personnel, volunteers, and USAWE affiliates for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, USAWE and/or competition management may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cablecasts, or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage, or benefit of the competition, sport, or USAWE. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. I understand and agree that copies of scoresheets may be retained for Licensed Officials Committee judge training purposes only.

In consideration for my participation in this Competition, I AGREE to the following:

- o I AGREE that USAWE and the Competition as used herein include the Licensee and competition management, as well as all of their officials, officers, directors, employees, agents, personnel, volunteers, and USAWE affiliates.
- o I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in the Competition with my horse as a rider, owner, or parent/guardian of a junior exhibitor. I am fully aware and acknowledge that horse sports and the Competition involve inherent dangerous risks of accident, loss, and serious bodily injury including broken bones, head injuries, trauma, pain, suffering, or death ("Harm").
- o I AGREE to hold harmless and release USAWE and the Competition from all claims for money damages or otherwise for any Harm to me or my horse and for any Harm of any nature caused by me or my horse to others, even if the Harm arises or results, directly or indirectly, from the negligence of USAWE or the Competition.
